

Newly Registered Imported Vehicles in FY 2017

The number of newly registered imported vehicles of foreign manufacturers for FY 2017 (April 2017 to March 2018) was 303,921, showing an increase by 1.7% from the same period of last year (298,856).

The total number of newly registered imported vehicles for FY 2017, including vehicles produced overseas by Japanese manufacturers, was 351,364, showing an increase by 1.3% from the same period of last year (346,905).
